



# Namibia Project Combinations

Good Hope Volunteers have introduced several new and exciting projects, and in Namibia, we can now provide a unique experience to our volunteers, where specially created packages offer continued support to ongoing conservation efforts throughout the country, as well as offering volunteers a chance to explore the most popular destinations.

The main projects in Namibia are Wildlife Conservation, Primary School Project and the Medical Project. These can be booked individually as stand-alone projects for their minimum pre-requisite duration, or combined with the various add-on projects, for a minimum of 1 additional week. The add-on projects are as follows: Namib Wilderness Experience, Wine & Wildlife Experience, Rehabilitated Wildlife Monitoring, Animal Husbandry Sanctuary, and Coastline Preservation.

We have prepared the best combinations with a variety of durations, which you can choose from according to the project's arrival and departure dates.



## Main Projects

### Wildlife Conservation



Their vision is an Africa where humans and wildlife can live and thrive together. Their mission is to conserve the land, cultures and wildlife of Namibia and rescue species threatened by an ever-shrinking habitat.

### Primary School



This primary school offers free education to children of the marginalised San Bushmen community, who would not normally receive any form of education. Providing this solid foundation of education means that these students are some of the first in Namibia to enter mainstream schools.

4-week minimum stay plus experience in teaching

### Medical Project



The project is committed to improving the lives of the San community through education, health care and improved living conditions. The project is a great choice for volunteers with an interest in health care, community service, nutrition, and medicine. However, having medical experience is by no means a requirement to take part. Anyone is welcome.

## Add-on projects in Namibia

These projects can be added to Wildlife Conservation, Primary School Project and the Medical Project for a duration of 1 week or longer. Due to fixed transfer days, we have formulated specific package itineraries which will work best.

### Namib Wilderness Experience



Based in Namibia's south, bordering the Namib Naukluft Park. Home to an array of desert adapted wildlife, this project encompasses 330 km<sup>2</sup> of desert scenery in which volunteers assist the onsite team by getting involved in vital conservation activities while enjoying the beautiful surroundings.



### Wine & Wildlife Experience\*



Located at the foot of Namibia's Naukluft Mountains, this project is a desert oasis and boasts one of the world's driest vineyards. It is a prime conservation site for the monitoring of wildlife species and due to its location, this project has evolved to introduce the beautiful landscape into daily adventure activities, combined with data collection in support of conservation monitoring.

### Rehabilitated Wildlife Monitoring



Located more in the north, this project comprises 350 km<sup>2</sup> of prime wildlife habitat. It is home to an array of wildlife species and the main role of this site is to provide a second chance and forever home to a great many rescued and rehabilitated animals. This includes wildlife coming from a variety of human-wildlife conflict cases across the country.

### Animal Husbandry Sanctuary



This wildlife sanctuary is located about 30 km away from the Medical Project in the east of Namibia. The sanctuary is almost 50 years old and caring for the many animals will be a wonderful experience for animal lovers. Volunteers at the Medical Project can also choose to spend time here on their weekends.

### Coastline Preservation\*



Located close to the coastal town of Swakopmund on the Namibian coast, this site focuses on beach clean-ups, as well as helping any wildlife in need. It is run by a designated project manager with a passion for and experience in marine biology. Volunteers can also do some adventure activities during their 7 days that will enhance their experience.
